CURRICULUM VITAE (SUMMARY)

JEAN-FRANÇOIS MOREAU, M.D., F.A.C.R., EMERITUS PROFESSOR OF RADIOLOGY

Jean-François Moreau, Medical Doctor and Emeritus Professor of Radiology, born 1938, graduated at the University of Rennes, France. He moved to the University of Paris in 1962. After he studied pediatrics and internal medicine, he matched with diagnostic radiology in 1971; he took the Assistant Professorship at the Necker Hospital Department of Urodiology, René Descartes-University of Paris V where he got tenured in 1975. His major fields of investigation involve genito-uroradiology, intracervical endocrine glands, soft tissues, contrast media toxicity and ultrasound. After two chairmanships in academic radiology departments at Celton Hospital (Issy-les-Moulineaux) and Boucicaut Hospital of Paris (1982-1989), he had become in 1988 the chairman of the new Department of Radiology at the Necker Hospital of Paris. He was the President of the Radiodiagnostic Section of the International Society of Radiology (1985-1989) and of the Paris International Congress of Radiology (ICR’89) and he served as the Treasurer of the ISR and was a co-chairman of ICR’96, Beijing. He is Past President and Founder of the European Society of Uroradiology and Past Treasurer of the European Federation of the Societies for Ultrasound in Medicine and Biology and Past-President of the French Society of Medical Ultrasound (SFAUMB). He is a Member of the International Society of Nephrology. He was the Editor-in-chief of “Journal de Radiologie” until 1996. He acted with Dr BJ Hillman as corresponding Editor of «Investigative Radiology» then «Academic Radiology» (1991-1997). He is founding member of the World Academy of Biomedical Technologies (1997) and he was Treasurer of Promedus. He is Honorary Fellow of the American College of Radiology (1990) and Honorary Member of the Bulgarian Society of Radiology (1995) of the Tunisian Society of Radiology (1997) and of the European Society of Uroradiology (2009). He received the ISR Antoine Bécère Medal (2000). He was member of the International Advisory Group and co-chairman of ICR’96, Beijing, China (1996), ICR’98, New Delhi, India (1998), ICR’2000, Buenos Aires, Argentina. He is listed in Who’sWho in the World 1997, in Who’sWho in Sciences and Ingeneering 1998, Who’sWho in Medicine & Health Care 1999 and in the Barons 500 Leaders for the 21th Century.
